Papers for oral presentations related to the above areas are invited. Please submit your paper by **31st August, 2017**. All manuscripts will be peer reviewed.



Submission Guide for Authors

1. Prepare your manuscripts

Manuscripts must include an abstract, keywords, an email address of the corresponding author and should not exceed four (4) pages, including tables, figures and references. Click the links below to download templates for preparing manuscripts for submission:

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Two types of manuscripts are accepted: regular paper and extended abstract.

Contributed papers are original submissions for this workshop, which present a general overview of your research fields. The page limit for regular paper is four (4) pages.

Extended abstracts are the extended abstracts for previously published papers (either conference or journal papers). We encourage the submissions that outline your work and its significant contributions published at high-quality venues.

2. Submit your manuscripts or 3MP slide

Go to <http://capsaus.org/SSO.aspx> to create a user account to submit your papers through CAPS Member System. This LOGIN page can also be accessed via HOME Page of CAPS Website <http://capsaus.org>, selecting “**Sign In**” on the upper right corner of the heading bar.



After you log into the system, click “Research Symposium” to move to the submission form. Select your submission from the following seven (7) categories: Biomedical and Health Sciences; Chemistry, Chemical Engineering, and Material Sciences; Civil, Environmental and Agricultural Engineering; Economics, Business and Management; Mathematics, Physics, Computer Sciences and IT; Mechanical,

Electrical and Electronic Engineering; Social Sciences and Humanities (Art, History, Education, Law, Politics and Philosophy).

Fill in the form with required details, click “*Choose file*” to upload your manuscript, and then click “*Submit*” to complete your submission. A submission record will pop up on the top of the page.

3. Review process

Our programme committee consists of professors and senior researchers. Each submission will be peer reviewed by at least two programme committee members.

Comments will be given about your submission. An email will be sent out by 25th September, 2017 to notify whether your submission has been accepted or not for session presentation (or 3MP Competition if applicable) .

4. Attending the Symposium

Submission of a manuscript should be regarded as an undertaking that, should the paper be accepted, at least one of the authors is registered for the symposium to present the work. For manuscripts accepted as session presentation, you are required to prepare a presentation for approximately 20 minute, depending on the allocated symposium session.

5. Awards

There are seven best oral presentation awards. These awards will be decided by on-site reviewers who are either senior programme committee members or invited keynote speakers of each parallel session.
